The J.A. Freitas Library is a Special Collections Library privately owned and operated by PFSA with funds from a Grant of the Louise Freitas Estate. The library collection consists of 12,000 works dealing with the Portuguese throughout the world. It holds a vast number of books on the Azores and a fairly complete sample of periodicals published by the Portuguese in California, some dating to the late 1880's. Most of the collection circulates for periods of two weeks each and books can be requested from anywhere in California through the inter-loan library services provided by most Public Libraries in California.
